# ABOUT ICELAND

Embark on an unforgettable 8-day self-drive expedition across Iceland, designed to maximize your chances of witnessing the magical Northern Lights.

Begin in Reykjavík, Iceland's vibrant capital, before tracing the dramatic South Coast — from thundering waterfalls to the black sand beaches of Vík.

Discover the wild beauty of Skaftafell and the surreal, iceberg-dotted Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon. Explore geothermal marvels at Gullfoss and Geysir, and walk between continents at Þingvellir National Park.

Venture through the Snæfellsnes Peninsula's glacier-capped volcanoes and coastal villages. Conclude your journey on the Reykjanes Peninsula, soaking in the mineral-rich waters of the Blue Lagoon.

Each night, step into the Arctic dark and look up — as the Northern Lights dance across the sky.

- Drive along Iceland's stunning South Coast past waterfalls and black sand beaches.
- Explore Skaftafell National Park and witness floating icebergs at Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon.
- Watch geysers erupt and feel the power of Gullfoss waterfall on the Golden Circle route.
- Walk between tectonic plates at the historic Þingvellir National Park.
- Discover geothermal springs, lava fields, and waterfalls in the Borgarfjörður region.
- Experience the raw beauty of Snæfellsnes Peninsula, often called "Iceland in Miniature."
- Travel through the volcanic landscapes and geothermal zones of Reykjanes Peninsula.
- Begin and end your adventure in vibrant Reykjavik, Iceland's cultural heart.
- Chase waterfalls like Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss, each more breathtaking than the last.
- Visit the black sand beach of Reynisfjara with its dramatic basalt columns.
- Spot seals and drifting icebergs at the serene Diamond Beach.
- Witness the magical Northern Lights dancing across Iceland's dark winter skies.
- Savor local Icelandic cuisine in remote countryside villages.
- Capture unforgettable photos under Iceland's moody skies and vast open terrain.
- Enjoy cozy overnights in handpicked lodges across the Icelandic countryside.

DAY 01

# Arrival in Reykjavik

TRANSFER TO THE HOTEL

Welcome to Iceland! Upon arrival at Keflavík International Airport, you'll be transferred to the capital city, Reykjavik.

Settle into your hotel and take the rest of the day to unwind or explore the charming streets of the world's northernmost capital. Depending on your arrival time, you can stroll along the scenic harbor, visit Hallgrímskirkja Church, or dine at one of the city's renowned seafood restaurants.

Overnight stay in Reykjavik.

DAY 02

# South Coast Highlights

WATERFALLS, LAVA FIELDS, AND BLACK SAND WONDERS

This morning, collect your **Land Rover Defender**, fully equipped for Iceland's winter terrain. After a vehicle briefing and route orientation, your self-drive adventure begins.

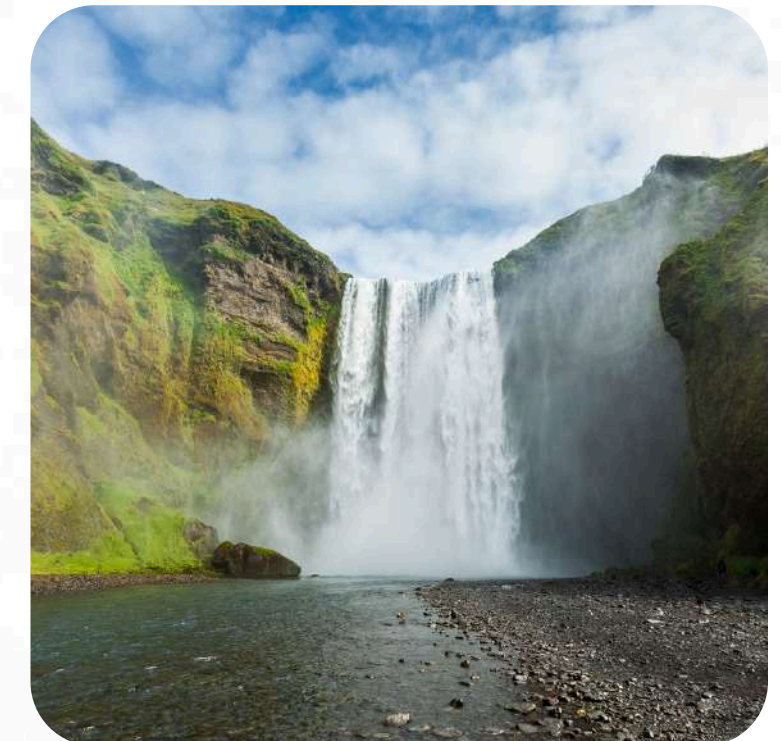
Head southeast along the South Coast, stopping first at Seljalandsfoss, where you can walk behind the curtain of water. Then visit the powerful Skógafoss, one of Iceland's most iconic waterfalls.

Continue past moss-covered lava fields and glacial plains, crossing Mýrdalssandur with views of Eyjafjallajökull along the way.

Arrive in the peaceful village of Kirkjubæjarklaustur by evening.

Overnight stay in Kirkjubæjarklaustur.

DAY 03

# Glaciers & Icebergs

SKAFTAFELL NATIONAL PARK AND JÖKULSÁRLÓN GLACIER LAGOON

Today's journey takes you deeper into Iceland's southeast, where glacial landscapes dominate the horizon. Begin with a visit to Skaftafell National Park, part of the vast Vatnajökull National Park, known for its dramatic ice-capped peaks and scenic hiking trails.

Continue east to the breathtaking Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon, where massive icebergs drift silently across the water. Just across the road lies the famous Diamond Beach, where ice chunks wash up on the black sand, creating a surreal contrast.

After soaking in the icy beauty, make your way back west toward the coastal village of Vík.

Overnight stay in around Vík.

DAY 04

# The Golden Circle

GULLFOSS, GEYSIR & GEOTHERMAL WONDERS

Leave the southern coast behind as you head inland toward Iceland's iconic Golden Circle. Your first stop is the thundering Gullfoss, one of Iceland's most famous and powerful waterfalls, cascading in two dramatic tiers into a rugged canyon.

Next, explore the Geysir Geothermal Area, where steaming vents and bubbling pools surround the erupting Strokkur, which shoots water up to 30 meters into the air every few minutes.

Enjoy scenic driving through rolling farmlands and geothermal fields before settling into your accommodation in the Geysir area.

Overnight stay near Geysir.

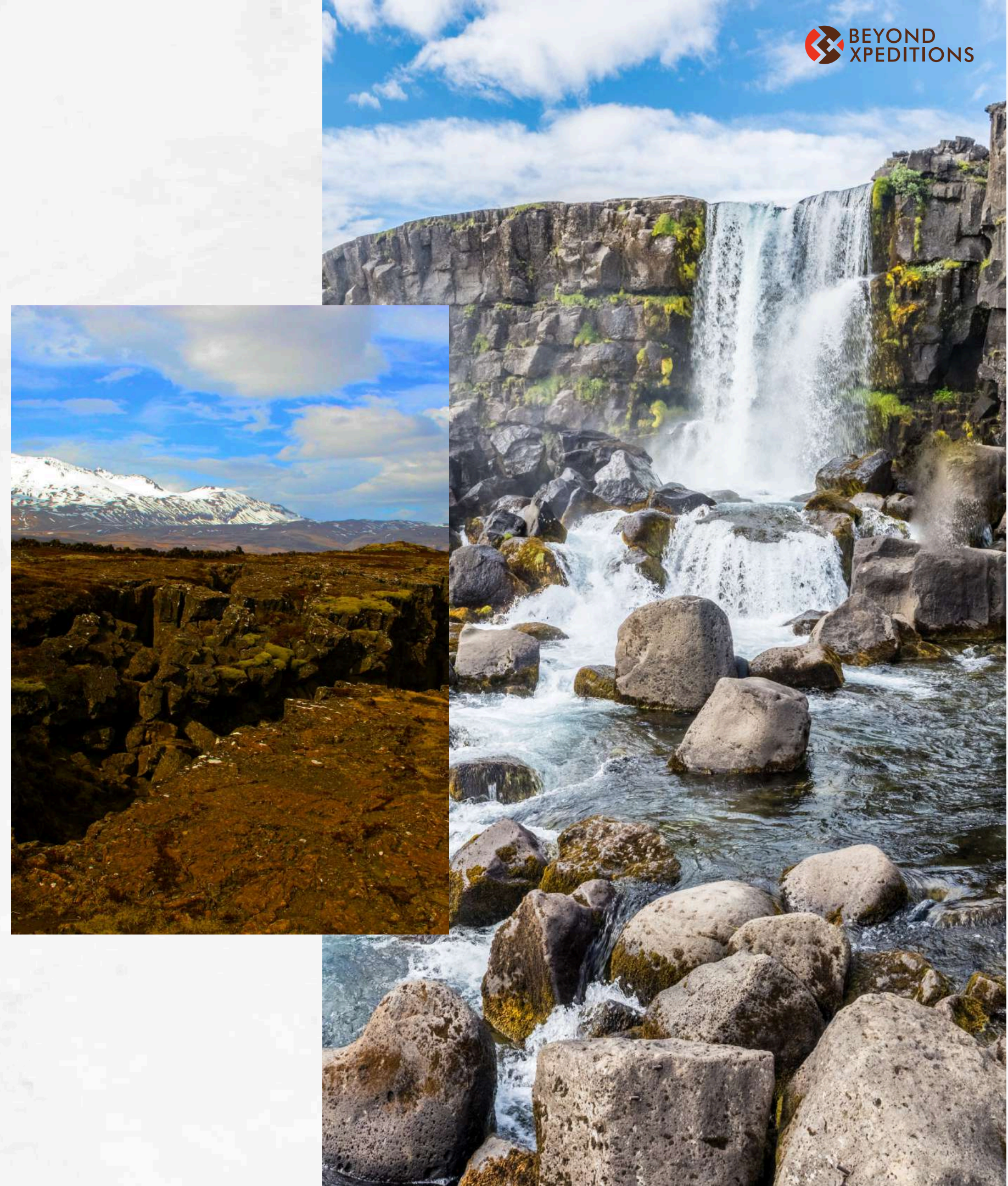
# Between Continents

ÞINGVELLIR NATIONAL PARK AND BORGARFJÖRÐUR REGION

Start your day with a visit to Þingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site where the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates drift apart. This rift valley is also home to Iceland's first parliament and offers striking views of lava fields, waterfalls, and fissures.

From there, continue west into the Borgarfjörður region, a less-traveled gem known for its geothermal activity and natural beauty. Stop at Deildartunguhver, Europe's most powerful hot spring, and visit Hraunfossar, where clear water flows out from beneath a lava field.

Settle in for the night in the town of Borgarnes, surrounded by mountains and fjords.

DAY 06

# Iceland in Miniature

SNÆFELLSNES PENINSULA EXPLORATION

Today is dedicated to the wild beauty of the Snæfellsnes Peninsula, often called “Iceland in Miniature” for its incredible variety of landscapes packed into one region.

From lava fields and rugged coastlines to fishing villages and volcanic peaks — this day captures the essence of Iceland in a single drive.

Visit the striking Kirkjufell Mountain, one of the most photographed spots in the country, and explore the dramatic Arnarstapi cliffs, where basalt formations meet crashing waves. If conditions allow, catch views of the mystical Snæfellsjökull Glacier, made famous by Jules Verne’s *Journey to the Center of the Earth*. Return to Borgarnes by evening.

# The Final Stretch

REYKJANES PENINSULA AND RETURN TO REYKJAVIK

On your final full day, explore the Reykjanes Peninsula, a geologically active region with steaming vents, bubbling mud pools, and dramatic coastal cliffs. Stop at the Bridge Between Continents, symbolically connecting the Eurasian and North American tectonic plates, and witness the colorful geothermal landscapes of Seltún.

Visit the famous Blue Lagoon for a relaxing soak in its mineral-rich waters, a perfect way to unwind before your return to the city.

Drive back to Reykjavik in the evening and enjoy your final night in Iceland's vibrant capital.

Overnight stay in Reykjavik.

- 90% refund if cancelled between 89 to 60 days before departure
- 75% refund if cancelled between 59 to 45 days before departure
- 50% refund if cancelled between 44 to 30 days before departure
- No refund if cancelled within 29 days of the departure date





# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## 1. Eligibility & Participation

- The person driving must be at least 18 years old and have a valid passport.
- This expedition is designed for individuals in good physical and mental health. Participants must disclose any medical conditions beforehand.
- Beyond Xpeditions reserves the right to accept or reject any participant in the interest of group safety and cohesion.

## 2. Booking & Payment

- 25% of the trip cost is required to confirm your slot.
- The balance payment must be completed no later than 45 days before departure.
- Payment schedules and deadlines will be strictly adhered to. Failure to comply may result in cancellation of participation.

## 3. Passport, Visa & Documentation

- Participants are responsible for securing a valid Schengen visa, passport (valid for 6 months), and IDP (if applicable).
- Beyond Xpeditions can provide visa guidance but is not liable for visa rejections or delays.

## 4. Vehicle Responsibility

- The Land Rover Defender will be provided on a shared basis (2 persons per vehicle). It includes unlimited mileage, Collision Damage Waiver (CDW), fuel, tolls, maintenance, and WiFi. Vehicles must be operated responsibly.



# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## 6. Itinerary & Weather Flexibility

- The itinerary is subject to change based on weather conditions, local regulations, or safety concerns.
- Any major route changes will be communicated by the Expedition Leader, whose decision will be final.

## 7. Risk Acknowledgement

- Participants acknowledge that this is a winter expedition involving potential risks such as slippery roads, extreme weather, and limited medical access.
- A mandatory indemnity form will be signed before departure.
- Beyond Xpeditons and its partners are not liable for any injuries, losses, or damages sustained during the trip.

## 8. Conduct & Cooperation

- All participants are expected to respect local cultures, laws, and group dynamics.
- Any behavior that endangers the group or disrupts the experience may result in removal from the expedition without refund.

## 9. Photography & Media

- By participating, you grant Beyond Xpeditons the right to use trip photos and videos (that may include your image) for marketing and social media purposes unless explicitly informed otherwise.

## 10. Insurance

- All participants must have travel insurance that covers international travel, emergency evacuation, and adventure activities.
